

Parking Information

USF POLICY REQUIRES PARKING PERMITS FOR ALL VEHICLES PARKED ON CAMPUS, 24 HOURS A DAY, 7 DAYS A WEEK.

Parking lot 38C in front of NEC building is a mixed-use lot with areas designated for Nonresident Students [S], Staff [E], and Visitors and has a parking permit machine as well as six short-term metered spaces within the Visitor lot. Please pay attention to signage and make sure you are parking in the correct area for your permit type.

Visitors: A parking fee of \$4 per day is charged for parking in designated visitor parking lots. Visitors parking in short-term metered spaces are required to pay the meter. Between 5:30pm and 7am, vehicles displaying a valid USF permit may park in [S] and [E] lots with the exception of Reserved Resident lots, reserved spaces, timed spaces, state vehicle spaces, and disabled parking (unless displaying a valid state-issued disabled permit along with the USF permit). Visitors may park up to 3 times per semester with a complimentary daily permit in Park-n-Ride lots 18 and 43. These permits are available through the Campus Information Center or at the Parking Services main office. Faculty, staff, vendors, and students do not qualify for visitor parking access.

HERE ARE 14 WAYS TO AVOID A TICKET:

- DO deposit money in the parking meters Mon.-Fri., 7am-5:30pm, even with a valid parking permit. After 5:30pm, only vehicles without a permit must deposit money into the meter.
- DO call Parking and Transportation Services (813/974-3990) or access their web site if you have questions about parking.
- DO display your valid USF parking permit on the vehicle's rearview mirror or dashboard with the logo facing out so it is clearly visible.
- 4. DO respond to parking citations to avoid immobilization or towing.
- 5. DO obey posted parking signs and barricades.
- DO pay attention to interior lot signs and/or pavement/curb markings that designate spaces in mixed lots, where multiple classifications or permits may be allowed.
- 7. DO use the USF Bull Runner to get around the Tampa campus.

- 8. DON'T park on the grass or on the sidewalk for any reason.
- DON'T block access to any disabled space and do not park in disabled spaces unless you have a state disability permit and a valid USF permit.
- DON'T park in reserved spaces, 15 or 30-minute timed spaces and disabled spaces unless you have the specific permit for that type of space.
- DON'T share your parking permit with others. The registered owner of the permit is responsible for ALL parking violations.
- DON'T buy your parking permit from anyone other than USF Parking and Transportation Services or Continuing Education. Permits bought from others could be lost or stolen permits and your vehicle would be subject to towing or immobilization.
- DON'T alter or change information on a parking permit. Doing so will result in your vehicle being cited and immobilized.
- DON'T block service drives or streets. If you do, your vehicle will be cited and may be towed.
