Hello, Janet. It was pleasure seeing you at the 491 Board meeting learner this week.

I have a question about rule 64B4-2.002(8) that we have received from a few members. That rule reads, "(8) No later than 90 days prior to June 30, 2021, the Board shall review and amend, modify, or repeal paragraphs (6) and (7) above if it determines that same creates barriers to entry for private business competition, is duplicative, outdated, obsolete, overly burdensome, imposes excessive costs, or otherwise negatively impacts the quality of psychotherapy received by Florida citizens."

Has the board reviewed (6) and (7) yet? Maybe I missed that from the rules meeting I did not attend. Our members are saying that they aren't sure if their interns are going to be able to continue practicing telehealth after 6/30 and are unsure if they should still be accepting new clients via telehealth.
